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## You Are the King's Kid

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7 Taurus 24'

Have you taken any hits to your self-esteem recently? I did. It was a mean, hard hit. At least this is the way I interpreted it. (I'm through it though, and I have had experiences to right the scales.)

Several people I know have also been similarly hit, and the Sun and Moon are in Taurus, the sign of self-esteem, and Saturn in Leo is square it, so I know this is more or less universal, that those of us who needed it have been set up.

Anything that seems to be having you for breakfast or keeping you out of the American Dream or the Promised Land is the negative manifestation of Saturn. You may see it as out there, but Taurus and Leo says it's in you. Out there is a mirror to show you aspects of yourself that you may have been hidden. Saturn in Leo, square Sun and Moon in Taurus says don't let anything throw dirt on your fire or pull the shade on your light. You must, though the going be tough, continue to radiate. You are the King's (Sun's) kid. Persist.

When something in our experience (Moon) tells us that we are flawed or otherwise preys upon us to make us vulnerable, to make us drop our treasure, the doubter slithers in and does its work below our awareness, in the generation of mental images that have us saying, "What was I thinking? I can't. I should give up. My efforts have come to so little and they shall not add up to much at the last. I might as well sit down. I might as well shut up. I might as well turn off my mind from dreaming and get realistic. And I shall feed the dreamer food, drink and drugs, for it must be fed something."

Let me recap for you my way of looking at the world, and the basis for these meditations on the map. The universe is orderly and every thing in it is tending toward good, even when it looks like the devil. The day-to-day experience is a mixture mostly of the conscious mind, (Mercury) and the subconscious mind (Moon). When you experience things out of kilter, out of line with what you want, it is not because disorder has claimed you and the negative has taken you for its own. Subconsciousness is linked to Superconsciousness (Sun). So is Self-consciousness, but via Subconsciousness. Self consciousness must look to subconsciousness in the day-to day-events, remembering that no matter what it looks like, Good is behind it and shall show Itself.
