Deborah, who lives in Brooklyn New York, was so motivated by her sister’s ideas and demonstrations, that she discovered a dream she didn’t even know she had—to be a publisher. She had always wanted to see Inez published as a reward for faithfully writing meditations inspired by the new and full moon cycles and tarot for 20
